Providing Education through Earn While You Learn

The arrival of August often brings one thought to mind... it's "back to school" time! At Next Step PIC the learning never stops for clients who are enrolled in our Earn While You Learn (EWYL) education program.

While anyone can enroll in the EWYL program, we primarily see expectant clients and new moms. We also encourage significant others or those supporting the new mama (such as mom or grandma) to enroll too! Clients enrolled in EWYL watch educational videos, fill out worksheets, and discuss what they've learned with Next Step Volunteers. Clients earn Boutique

Bucks for each lesson they complete and may then shop in our Blessings Boutique which is stocked with items such as baby clothes, diapers, personal hygiene items, maternity clothes, and gift cards for gas or food.



For our expectant clients, topics range from pregnancy and prenatal development to

breastfeeding support and early childhood milestones. We encourage these clients to continue seeing us for up to two years after baby's arrival! We also have lessons on healthy relationships, parenting, and STD/STI education.
