### Pregnancy & Infant Loss Awareness

October is Pregnancy and Infant Loss Awareness month and includes (but is not limited to) loss as a result of miscarriage, stillbirth, newborn death, or SIDS (sudden infant death syndrome). The American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists estimates that up to 25% of clinically recognized pregnancies end in loss. Stillbirths, which are infant loss after the 20th week of pregnancy, occur in approximately 1 in 160 pregnancies. Each year around one million pregnancies end in loss in the US alone. In addition, current trends show that approximately 22,000 infants pass away each year due to causes including SIDS, birth defects, and complications after preterm birth.

Pregnancy and infant loss is is all around us, yet most of us are unaware until we experience it personally. We live in a culture where individuals and families grieve through these losses alone and in silence. In this newsletter, Next Step PRC hopes to raise awareness and highlight the services we have available for individuals who have experienced this crippling form of loss.

## Light a Candle with Us

#### Participate in the Global Wave of Light Event

On October 15th at 7:00 PM local time, individuals around the world light a candle to remember babies who have been lost, leaving that candle lit for 1 hour. This creates a global wave of light for 24 hours. This annual event is known as the Wave of Light event and is recognized by most 1st world nations. Finding Peace after Abortion

#### Before:

"I had not allowed myself to cry for years and years. Since having an abortion I was afraid that if I started crying I might not be able to stop. So I just held it in."

"The unresolved conflicts surrounding my past abortion had messed with me. I felt isolated....lost."

"Black and white. That describes how my world came to look in the years following my abortion."

The three women who made those statements are among the many who have participated in Next Step's Post Abortion Healing (PAH). Some join an eight-week group, while others opt for one-on-one sessions. If you or someone you know is struggling with a past abortion, call our office and ask to speak with one of the PAH team leaders. These women have walked in your shoes; they understand and will walk with you.

#### After:

"I cannot explain what a relief it has been to be able to cry when I'm sad!"

"I am FOUND. I am not lost. I am FOUND."

"My world is in color again! The sky is blue, the grass is green!"
