A Story of Courage and Hope

Looking back on the year

I'm told that everybody has a rock bottom. I'm told that rock bottom is different for everyone.

For my niece (let's call her Carla, because it means warrior), I think it was looking her own mortality in the eye. I believe it was in the discovery that she was helpless to beat her addiction alone. When Carla first came into our lives, it was by marriage. I was struck by her natural beauty and her brown eyes. She was like any other kid, playful, goofy, silly, and friendly.

As I sat in the courtroom just a few short years later, I watched her, just a shadow of the girl I knew, try to convince the judge that she would never use meth again. Her mom explained to him all the reasons that she knew she could not have her come home. She felt Carla would eventually die from her meth use. I wish I had enough space to go into what a brave hero I think this woman is but this is Carla's story. The week before, we had all waited in the hospital wondering if she was dead. We had all admitted to ourselves that if she lived, this was probably her last chance. And here we were in the courtroom, her mom trying to convince a judge who probably hadn't lived with this, that letting Carla come home was without any doubt a death sentence for her.

Thankfully, he listened. She was admitted to a recovery program and then a group home and then something we called "Baby Prison". It was a lock up for youth to give them a chance to learn how to get along with others and not use drugs and hopefully get them clean enough to appreciate it while locking out outside influences. When I visited her there, I had to go through a metal detector and to some degree was "frisked" to be sure I wasn't bringing her drugs. We were allowed a short visit. She came out of Baby Prison clean, sober and a little scared to start a new life.

Fast forward about 4 years; I was a new advocate in training at Next Step. Carla came to me, "Auntie, I'm pregnant and he wants me to have an abortion." (continued on next page)

I felt so unprepared. She fed me things to say to Carla and told me to speak from my heart. I think that having an abortion in my story helped to convince Carla that she wanted to keep her baby.

I credit Next Step and the Post Abortion Healing Bible Study (which I had to take to be able to work here) for being able to talk to Carla about the path she was about to take.

We have recently celebrated Baby's first birthday and Carla has been a client of Next Step for two years. She attends a local church regularly. I do credit that precious baby for so much of the good and the hope that has been in her life.

Carla is a wonderful mother and she has been clean and sober for six years.

Looking Forward Growing and changing

As Next Step PRC grows, we are realizing just how big of a need we are filling in our community. We are also realizing that there is a much bigger load placed on a lot smaller number of volunteers. We'll let the numbers speak for themselves:
