Surrendering the Secret

An Abortion Recovery Group Testimony

"Hello, my name is Amanda. When I was 20 I got pregnant and give birth in March when I was 21. It was just the two of us. In October I got pregnant again. I was devastated. I didn't know how I was going to take care of two babies. So I made the choice not to keep the baby. I called Next Step and they told me they don't refer to abortion clinics so I researched and found one on my own. I was young, scared, and didn't know what I was getting into. When I got there they did an ultrasound; I was having twins. Faced with this news I started to have second thoughts, but the abortion clinic doesn't give you time for that. They just keep going on with the procedure. It was the worst thing I have ever gone through! It makes you feel ashamed, dirty, and sad. I didn't want people to know what I had done.

Years later I had a friend talk to me about the abortion recovery program Next Step offers and the healing it brought her. I prayed about it and decided God was telling me it was time. I started "Surrendering the Secret" with an open mind, hoping for healing. What I got was so much more. I got answers to prayers and more healing then I could have ever asked for. I found out...
