Next Step Continues to Grow in 2019

2019 has kicked off with a bang at Next Step PIC and we are bustling with clients! We have had four clients earn enough *boutique bucks* through our Earn While You Learn program to purchase car seats!

Not only are we seeing more clients participating in our current programs, but we are adding new client services as well. Our new program known as First Step is taking off right now. First Step teaches life skills and risk avoidance including pre-marital sex, alcohol use, and drug abuse. This program is designed for ages 4th grade up through college age and is multifaceted for use in churches, schools, groups, and one-on-one settings. First Step is currently being implemented in one local school and a second plans to begin the program this spring. Feedback from parents and students alike has been excellent.

Because of our steady growth Next Step has transitioned to a team of three part-time directors, each with specific roles. This transition was adopted based on Ecclesiastes chapter 4, specifically verse 12: "a cord of three strands is not easily broken."

Once someone decides to become a client advocate they will need to sign Next Step's statement of faith and participate in a training program. Training includes classroom-style teaching as well as the opportunity to watch and assist current client advocates. Training usually takes a few months to complete but is flexible based on the availability of the trainee.
